# MEETING MINUTES January 17, 2024

# 1. Call to Order / Roll Call / Introductions

A regular meeting of the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council, Technical Advisory Committee was called to order by Chair Alberto Ayala at 1:32 pm via Zoom teleconference. Attendees were as follows:

Butte County AQMD – Patrick Lucey Colusa County APCD – Anastacia Allen Feather River AQMD – Chris Brown *Glenn County APCD – Allyson Smith joined meeting during Status Reports* Placer County APCD – Erik White Sacramento-Metropolitan AQMD – Alberto Ayala, Amy Roberts Shasta County AQMD – Rob Stahl Tehama County APCD – Joe Tona Yolo-Solano AQMD – Gretchen Bennitt SMP Coordinator – Kai Tawa California Air Resources Board – Adam Gerber QEEPS – Casey Ryan BCC Secretary-Treasurer – Laurie LaGrone

Mr. Ryan was introduced and welcomed as the 2024 QEEPS liaison.

### 2. Period of Public Comment

Mr. Ayala opened the floor to public comment; hearing none, public comment period was closed.

# 3. 2024 TAC Chair & Vice Chair Appointment

**Motion:** Mr. Tona moved to nominate Rob Stahl of Shasta County as Chair and Joe Tona of Tehama County as Vice Chair for 2024. Ms Allen seconded the motion, and the motion passed with no opposition or abstentions. The meeting passed to the new Chair Rob Stahl.

# 4. Approval of Minutes from December 20, 2023 Meeting

Mr. Ayala noted that a reference to taking legal action (Item #8) was incorrect and should be removed.

**MOTION:** Mr. Ayala moved to approve the minutes with the noted correction, seconded by Mr. Brown, and the motion passed with no opposition or abstentions.

# 5. Approval of Financial Status Report as of December 31, 2023

Ms. LaGrone submitted financial reports through December 31, 2023, and warrants to be paid.

**MOTION:** Mr. White moved to approve the financial reports as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Tona, and the motion passed with no opposition or abstentions.

# 6. Status Reports

• <u>CAPCOA</u> – Mr. Tona and Mr. White offered a report of the CAPCOA winter board meeting. Discussions included a possible future relocation of the CAPCOA office, the governor's proposed budget, and the desire to engage more with CARB's board of directors.

CAPCOA submitted a letter of support for CalEEMod funding.

The next CAPCOA meeting will be February 21-22.

The CAPCOA rural districts met recently to discuss the Carl Moyer program, administrative fees and allocation fees. The conversation will continue at the February meeting.

- <u>QEEPS</u> Mr. Ryan said that much of the discussion at the January 11 meeting was about the 2024 Triennial Air Quality Attainment Plan. The next meeting will be March 14 at Glenn County APCD.
- <u>CA Air Resources Board (CARB)</u> Mr. Gerber had no report, but answered a question about CARB's meteorology section. He said that with five staff meteorologists and a new data base programmer, the section is fully staffed for the first time in 15 years. Their programmers are working on PFIRS upgrades.
- <u>SMP Coordinator</u> Mr. Tawa has completed his Fall Intensive Burn Season summary report and added it to the chat for members. He listed the report's highlights and answered member questions.

### 7. Agricultural Biomass Conference Summary Report – Amy Roberts

Ms. Roberts presented her final report of the October Biomass conference, with very few changes to the draft. Changes to Table 2 were proposed.

**MOTION:** Ms. Allen moved to accept the summary report with the noted changes to Table 2. Mr. White seconded the motion, and the motion passed with no opposition or abstentions.

### 8. Member Reports and Future Agenda Items

Mr. White reported that San Joaquin Valley is interested in collaborating with other air districts for CPRG programs. Mr. Ayala agreed to be the point person for TAC/BCC in discussions with San Joaquin Valley. Mr. Ayala offered that the latest EPA feedback about CPRG is they favor regional strategies and coalitions.

Mr. White said that the Farm Bill is currently up for consideration, and asked if some of the group's discussion points could be included in the Farm Bill.

Mr. Ayala reported that CARB is committed to releasing a CPRG PCAP Phase I Action Plan to the public this winter.

Members requested a standing agenda item for CPRG on this year's TAC and BCC agendas.

Mr. Stahl said that Shasta County has entered a two-year pilot program for a reactive calcium carbonate plant – similar to Portland cement but producing less CO2. After two years its feasibility will be evaluated and a larger plant may be built.

**9. Communications and Reminders** – BCC Secretary The FPPC filing date for Form 700 is April 1, 2024.
